Charles Chaplin was a famous actor and producer. He created many films about *humanity, peace, and equality. He was called “the King of Comedy”. Before he became famous, however, his life was quite tragic.

Charles was born in London in 1889. His parents were both actors. His father was successful until he began drinking. He left the family when Charles was only one year old. For his mother, brother, and himself, life was not easy.

His mother worked very hard to earn money for her family but she could not make enough money. She began to suffer from illness of the mind. When he was five years old, his mother fell ill and lost her job. Eventually, he and his brother were sent to a house for poor children. He spent most of his childhood there and he felt lonely and sad.

Even in his teenage years, Chaplin remained unhappy. He had no dream and no hope, and he moved from job to job. Finally at the age of 17, he joined a theater company in London. However, he was not satisfied yet. Later, he described how he felt during those early years in the theater.

“Routine work was boring, and the world was hard. There was no bright future for me. I could only imagine an uninteresting life. I was getting depressed. On Sundays, I often took a walk in the park and listened to the music there. I didn’t want to be alone, but I didn’t want to be with anyone else, either. Then, I fell in love with a girl, but ⁽¹⁾that love was never returned.”

He had such a difficult time when he was young, but . The experience of hardship made him “the King of Comedy”.

His performances were a great success not only in London, but also in other cities. Then he got a chance to work for a film company in the US. There he created the famous character “⁽³⁾the Little *Tramp”.

“One day, a movie director told me, ‘Wear something funny. Do anything that you want to do.’ I thought I would wear very large pants, big shoes, a small hat, and a *mustache. I also thought I would hold a walking stick. I wanted everything to look strange. At this time, the character was born in my mind.”

Chaplin played the role of “the Little Tramp” many times in the movies. In the movie *City Lights*, Chaplin played a homeless person who was brave with a kind heart. The role seemed to reflect the hardship of his early life. In the movie *Modern Times*, he showed the tough life of workers in those days.

The stories in these films seem sad but , and at the same time they warm the hearts of the audience. In the movie *The Great *Dictator*, Chaplin even made fun of leaders who were

bringing their countries to war.

Chaplin talked about how society was unfair and sometimes ridiculous. He showed this from the perspective of people who were not powerful and who were living in poverty. He explained it in a simple way. So, people could understand how these unhappy people felt. He once said, “Yes, life is wonderful if you’re not afraid of it.” It means that if you have the courage to face life without fear, you can find how wonderful it is. He believed that all you need is courage, imagination, and a little money.
